LI Coalition for the Homeless Program – March 6, 2016

Thank you to all who came to the Dix Hills Jewish Center on Sunday, March 6, 2016 to participate in a mitzvah project to benefit the Long Island Coalition for the Homeless. More than 50 people participated. The Executive Director of the Coalition, Greta Guarton, spoke to the group about the current homeless situation on Long Island and highlighted the facts, including that there are currently 4,000 homeless people on Long Island, including 2,000 children, and she described some of the programs offered by the Coalition to help. After Greta spoke, donations that were brought in were sorted and packed into bags, and later delivered to the LI Coalition's building. 100% of these donations will be distributed by the Coalition to the homeless on Long Island. Those who attended -- both children and adults -- stated that they learned a great deal about the homeless. It was a high impact morning for all!
