Rabbi Swerdlow, after obtaining Smicha at Hebrew Union College, began his career as an Army Chaplain in Vicenza, Italy, the first Jewish Chaplain to serve there since World War II. Rabbi Swerdlow also joined the 361st General Hospital where he would spend the next seventeen years as its Chaplain. Beginning as a Captain and rising to the rank of Colonel. After a long army career, he retired as a Colonel, and went on to the Northport VA Medical Center where he rose to lead chaplain and continues to serve.
