All recite together.

Hinei Eil y'shu-ati, evtach v'lo efchad, ki ozi v'zimrat yah Adonai, va-y'hi li lishua.
U'shavtem mayim b'sason mima-ai-nei hay-shu-a. Ladonai hay-shu-a,
al amcha birchatecha sela. Adonai tz'va-ot imanu, misgav lanu elohei Ya-akov, sela,
Adonai tz'va-ot, ashrei adam botei-ach bach. Adonai hoshia, hamelech ya-aneinu v'yom koreinu.

All recite together, then the leader repeats:

La-y'hudim ha-y'ta ora v'simcha, v'sason vicar. Kein tiyeh lanu.
Kos y'shu'ot esa, uv-sheim Adonai ekra.

Raise the cup of wine and recite:

Baruch atah Adonai Eloheinu melech ha-olam, borei p'ri hagafen.

Put down the wine without drinking.

Hold the spicebox and recite:

Baruch atah Adonai Eloheinu melech ha-olam, borei minei v'samim.

Inhale the spices.

Extend your hands toward the Havdalah candle:

Baruch atah Adonai Eloheinu melech ha-olam, borei m'orei ha-eish.

Raise the cup of wine once more:

Baruch atah Adonai Eloheinu melech ha-olam, hamavdil bein kodesh l'chol, bein or l'choshech, bein
Yisrael la-amin, bein yom hashvi-l l'sheishet y'mei hama-aseh. Baruch atah Adonai, hamavdil bein
kodesh l'chol.

Drink some wine, then extinguish the flame of the candle in the remaining wine.

Hamavdil bein kodesh, bein kodesh l'chol, chatoteinu hu yimchol.
Zareinu v'chaspeinu yarbeh kachol, v'chakochavim balaila. Shavua Tov!
