

# Mehirat Hametz - Passover

## THE SELLING OF LEAVENED PRODUCTS

The sale of hametz is an important part of our Passover preparations. Hametz is defined broadly as all fermented grain and grain products, as well as food and liquids made from them (even if only using a minute amount). Moreover, hametz includes dishes/utensils which are used during the rest of the year; therefore separate sets of dishes/utensils are set aside for Passover use. (It is possible to kosher some dishes/utensils for Passover. Contact the Rabbi).

The Torah prohibits both the consumption and the possession of hametz during Passover. Since financial considerations make it virtually impossible to literally fulfill the biblical command to remove ALL leavened products – it would necessitate destroying our year-round dishes annually before Passover – our sages instituted the practice of selling our leavened products. Thus Jews are reminded of the necessity to divest themselves of legal ownership of all hametz during Passover.

This legal transaction is arranged by the Rabbi acting on behalf of those congregants who authorize him to sell their hametz. The transaction transfers all hametz which may physically remain in the home to a non-Jew who has title to the hametz during Passover. After Passover, the Rabbi repurchases the hametz, which we may resume using.

The custom we adhere to when Pesach commences on a Saturday evening is to store all hametz away by mid-morning Friday, March 26. We do not consume matzah until the first Seder on Saturday evening. Our Shabbat meals are Kosher for Passover and egg matzah is used in place of hallah!



### AUTHORIZATION FOR SALE OF HAMETZ

It is customary to contribute to the “Maot Chitim” (Passover food) Fund at this time.

Checks are to be made out to the “NY Board of Rabbis Passover Fund” (tax deductible).
